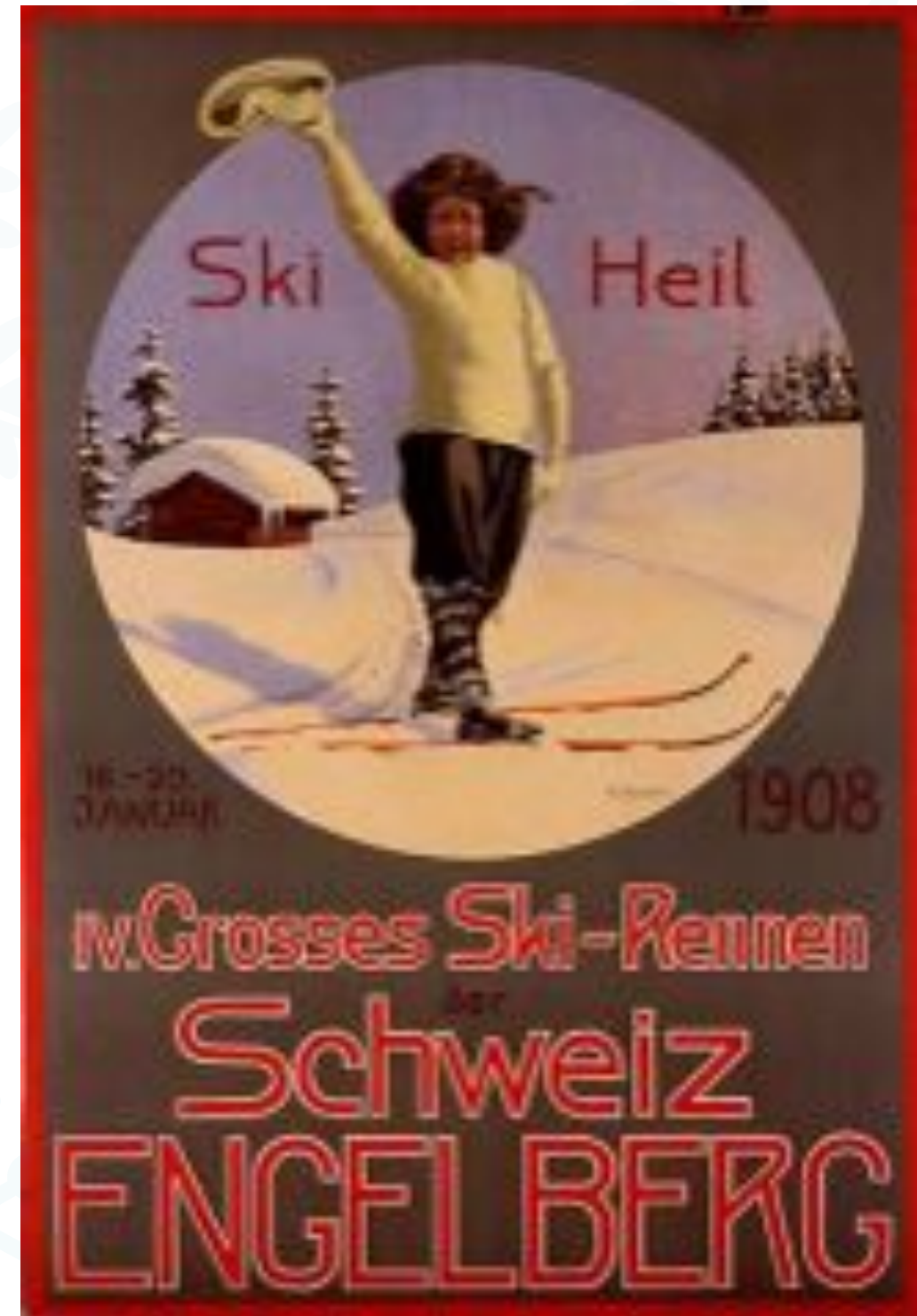
For skiers of a certain age, these beautiful images form a touchstone in our collective memory.

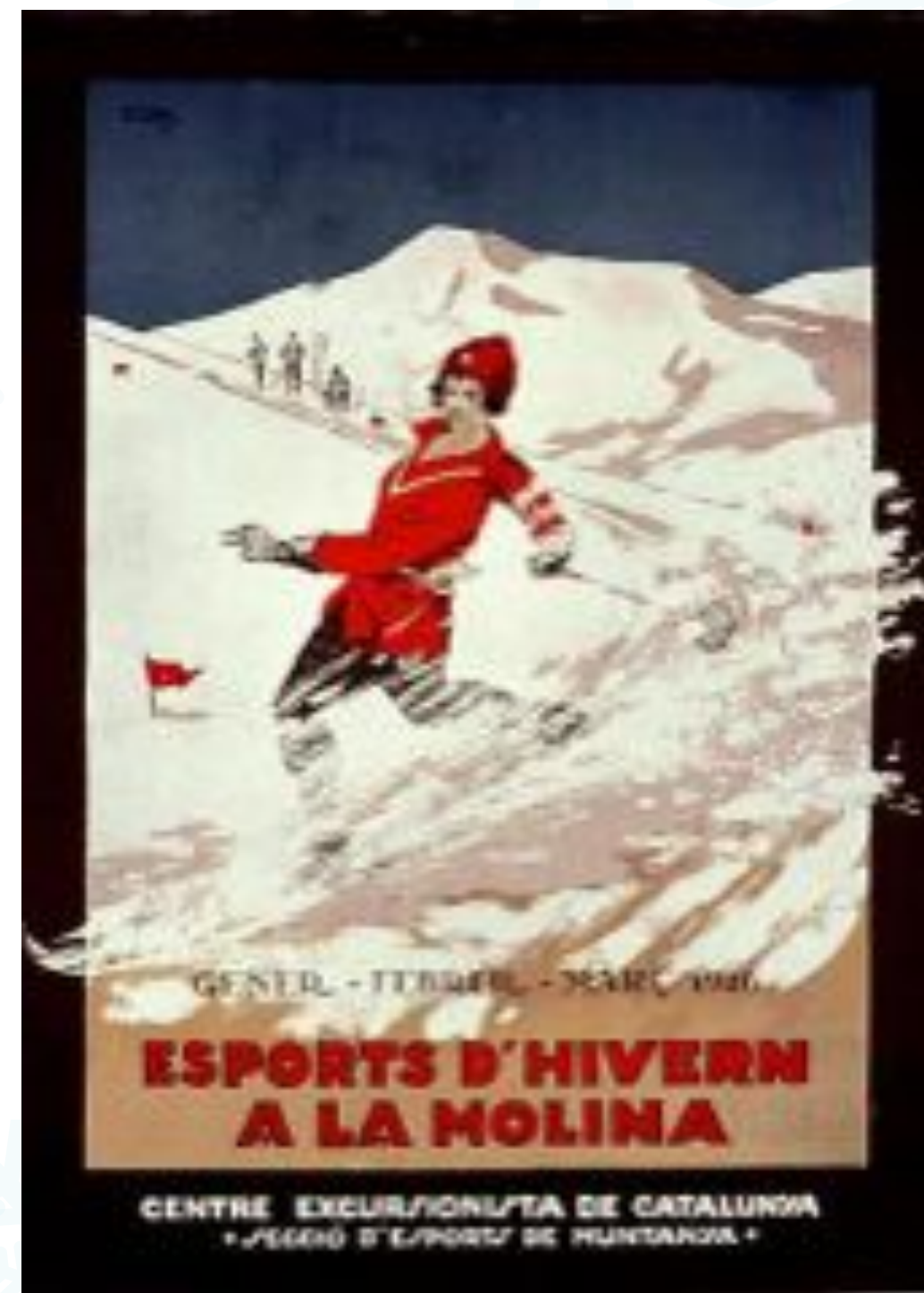

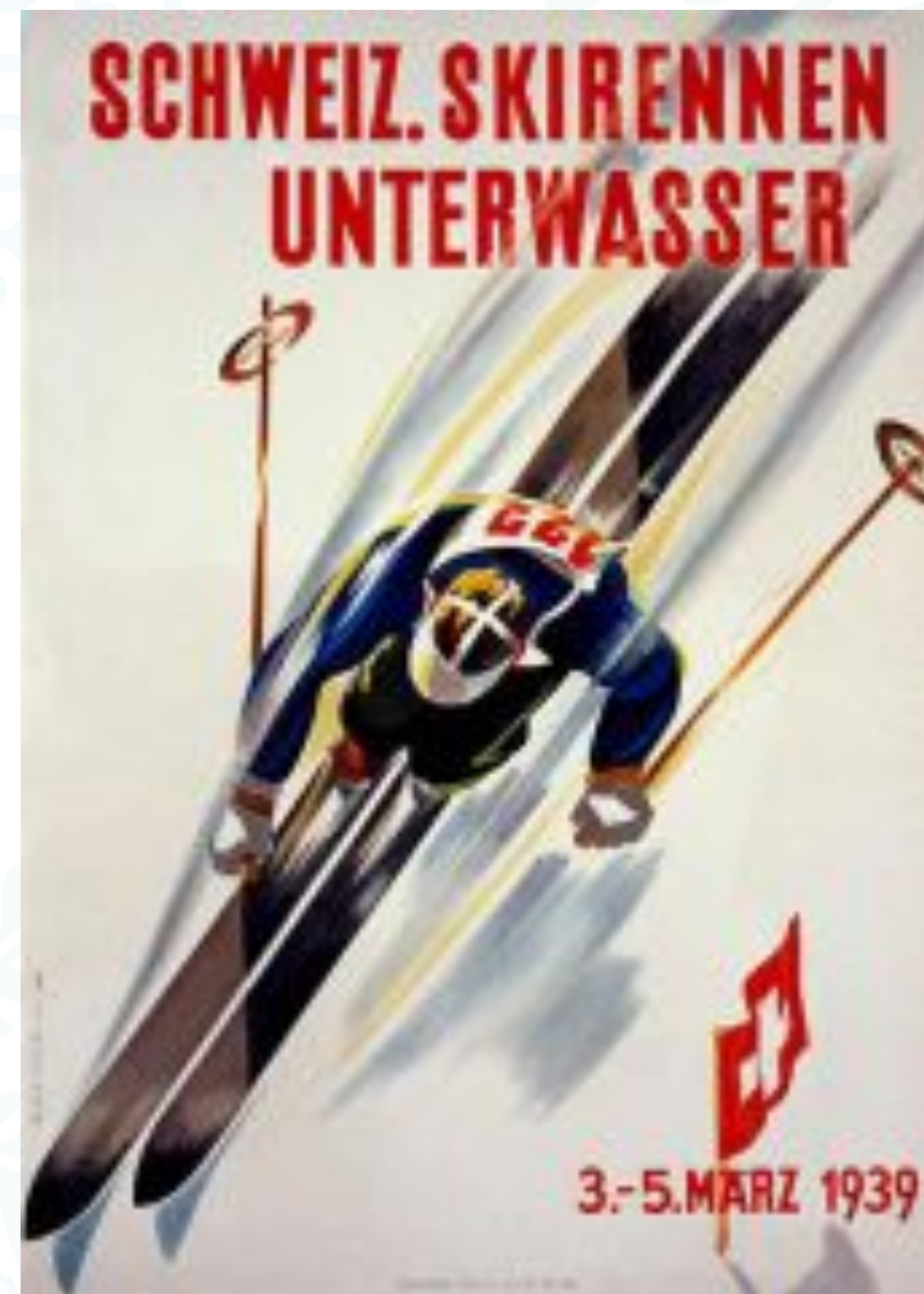
